

# LIBERTY HILL CHILD NUTRITION DEPARTMENT CHARGE POLICY

Students are allowed to charge up to:

- 4 Reimbursable Meals at Liberty Hill Elementary & Bill Burden Elementary School
- 3 Reimbursable Meals at Liberty Hill Intermediate, Junior High & High School

*If the students account exceeds the allowable reimbursable meal charges, the student will receive an Alternate meal which consists of a cheese sandwich and carton of milk for the price of \$0.75*

A la Carte charging is not permitted.

Adults are not allowed to charge Meals or A la Carte items.

Cash and Check Prepayments may be made to your cafeteria account at any time during cafeteria hours
